B. Demonstrations and Illustrated Talks	Junior: 7 - 13 years of age	10 minutes

C. Public Speaking (outline required)	14 years and older	15 minutes
D. Model Meeting (secretary will turn in up-to-date secretary's notebook and model meeting notes. Parliamentary problem will be provided 10 minutes early.)	club groups	35 minutes (roll call excluded, recreation included)

## SECTION 2 MUSIC AND TALENT

**\*\*NOTE: All musical performances - Judge requires ORIGINAL music with numbered measures. If a 4-Her has a CD, they are still required to have original music with numbered measures.**

Type	Participants	Limits
A. Chorus	Composed of 16 or more from one club or a composite group from two or more clubs (if club membership is below 16, a chorus of 12 is acceptable)	2 numbers
B. Vocal Ensemble	Club or composite group from two or more clubs, of 2 - 15 participants	2 numbers
C. Vocal Solo	Individual	1 number
D. Orchestra or Band	Club or composite group from two or more clubs, 16 or more participants	2 numbers
E. Instrumental Ensemble	Club or composite group from two or more clubs, 2 - 15 participants	2 numbers
F. Instrumental Solo	Individual	1 number
G. Piano Solo	Individual	1 number

*must be same for both songs*

Type	Participants	Limits
H. Individual Dance	Individual	5 minutes
I. Small Dance Group	2 - 4 participants	5 minutes
J. Medium Dance Group	5 - 12 participants	5 minutes
K. Large Dance Group	13 or more participants	5 minutes
L. Creative Drama (costumes, props and theatricals are acceptable)	Any number of participants	5 - 15 minutes
M. Skit	Any number of participants	0 - 5 minutes
N. Reading (memorization optional; no costumes, props or theatricals)	Individual	5 minutes
O. Other (novelty, stunt, puppets, ventriloquist, etc.)	No limit	5 minutes
